

Tips for Great Photography

- **Closer is better!** Get close to your subject
- Keep backgrounds **simple and uncluttered** – beware of **mersers!**
- Be aware of the lighting and its relation to your subject:
 - Sun or light source should be **behind** you or to the side of your subject
 - Use Fill Flash, if necessary
 - Use flash 6-12 feet from subject
- Plan your shot, if possible - use good composition techniques:
 - Rule of Thirds
 - Framing
 - Use of interesting lines and “S” curves
 - Use Focus Lock, if necessary
- Shoot at highest resolution for best results when printing
- Shoot at eye level unless looking for an unusual perspective
- **Hold Camera Steady!**
